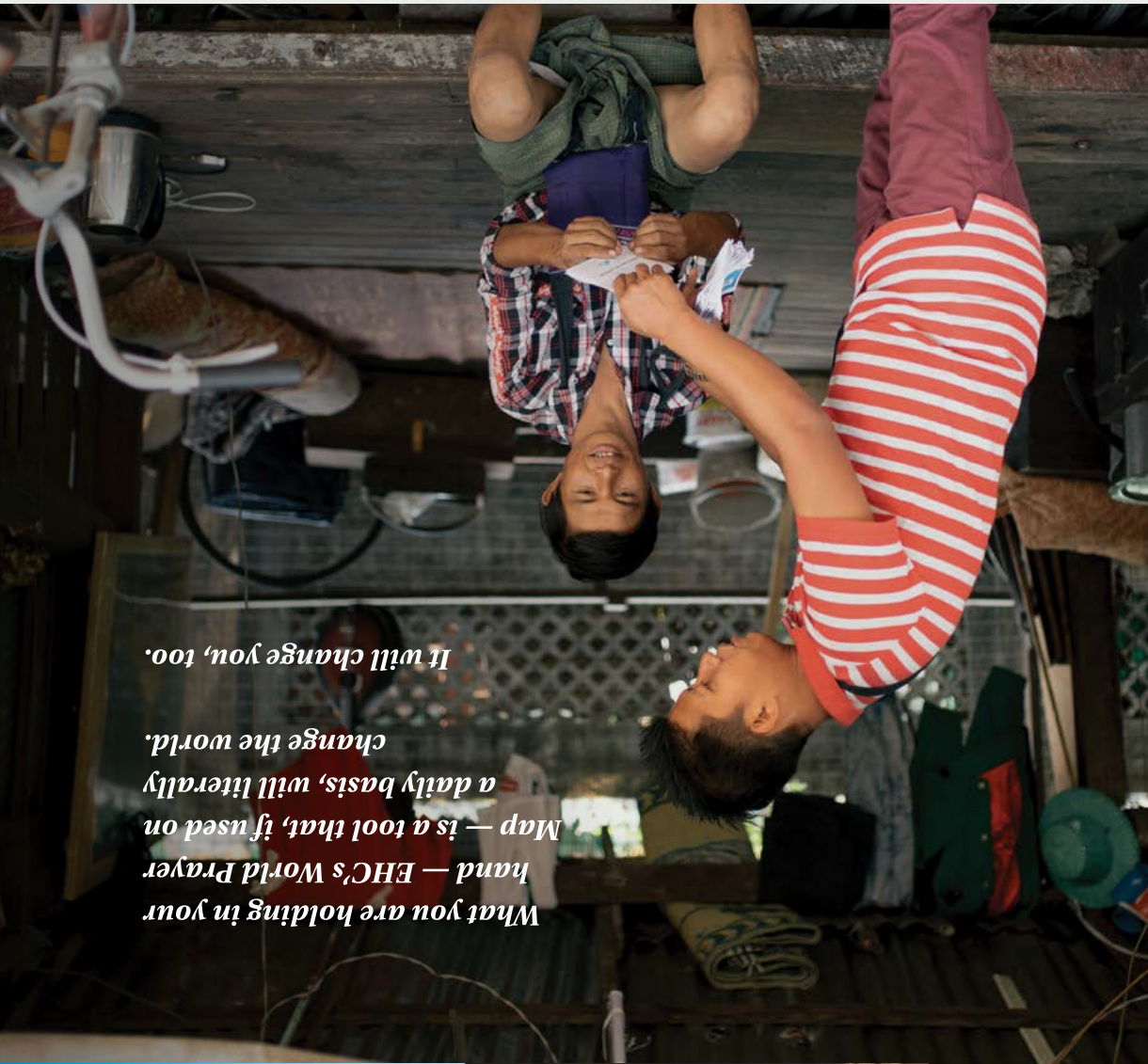


1. The Great Commission must be taken literally.

YOUR HARVEST IS WAITING...

Because we know how their stories ended, it can be hard for us to comprehend just how overwhelming the Great Commission was for the Early Church. Jesus commissioned His disciples to go into all the world and preach the Gospel to all creation. Yet they were only 12 young men, mostly poor and uneducated. And only days earlier, they had been hiding behind locked doors, fearful and discouraged. Suddenly they go from hiding to the harvest! Their assignment — "all nations" and "every creature"!

The same vision that so captured that first generation of believers has captured the hearts of the global Every Home for Christ family, and that is why the OIKOS Initiative has been launched. It is a simple challenge: reach every OIKOS (the Greek word used in the New Testament for "family" or "household") on the earth with a presentation of the Gospel in one generation.

Saying it is simple — but to actually reach 7.6 billion people on the earth is no easy task. That's a lot of people engaging with the Gospel (approximately 130 million homes to reach each year). We go because we want to be obedient to the call of Jesus, and we go because everyone matters. Think about it: Can you identify a neighborhood on the face of the earth that shouldn't hear the Good News and be touched by the transforming power of Jesus? Can you think of a family or even a person the Gospel shouldn't reach? We can't think of one either — and that is why we need you to join the team as well.

"Don't go to heaven without your harvest!"



WILL YOU HOLD THE ROPE?

In 1792 the first Baptist Missionary Society was formed in Great Britain. The "Father of Modern Missions," William Carey, was soon to travel down to India to sow his life for the Gospel. Carey is reported to have looked at his fellow believers, all committed to the Great Commission of Jesus, and said, "Well, I will go down, and you will hold the rope."

Carey had grasped a key concept in missions — partnership. God supplies for the needs of one part of Christ's Body through the generous gifts of another part.

Indigenous Pioneer Missionaries all around the world are reaching their nations with the Gospel because of the financial partnership of believers like you.

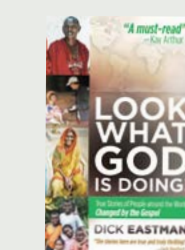

Kids Prayer Map

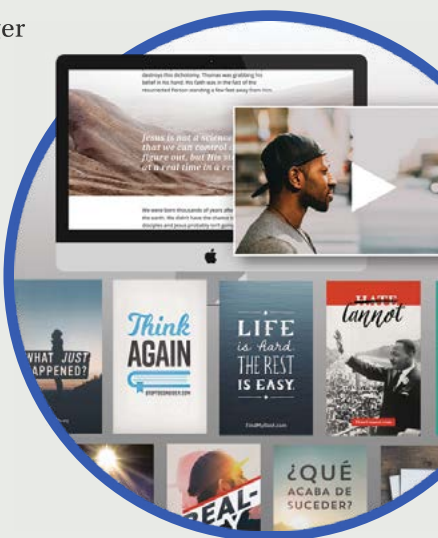

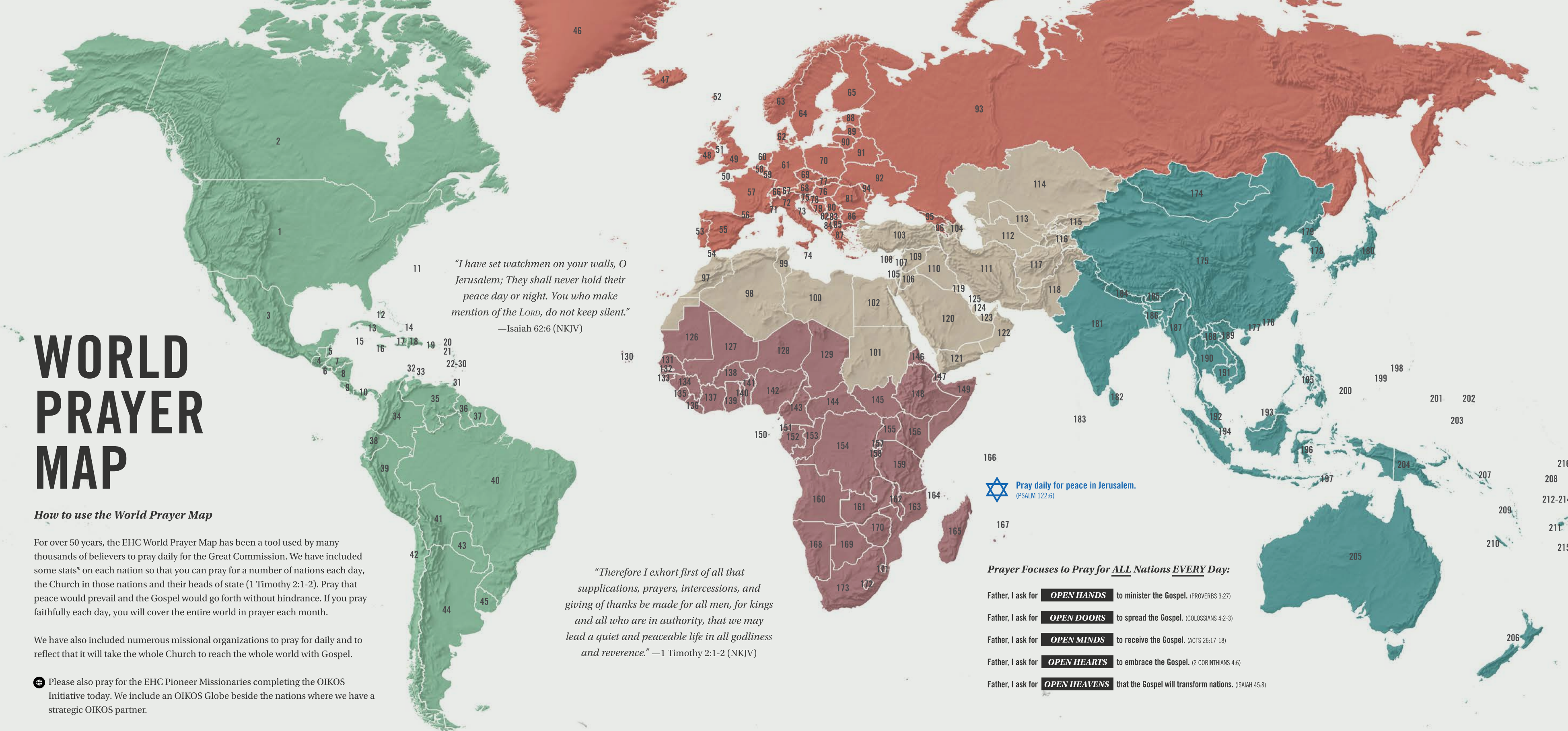
THE HOUR THAT CHANGES THE WORLD
